

Young Fives Supply Lists

Required Items:

Washable markers - 2 boxes (10 packs only please)

Glue Sticks - 10

Child-sized scissors (please clearly label with your child's name)

Pencil box (the plastic kind please. Please also label w/child's name).

Backpack (large enough to hold a folder). Label w/child's name.

Headphones (send to school in a baggie w/child's name).

Indoor shoes (these will be kept at school). Label w/child's name.

Optional items:

Paper plates

Paper Towels

Kleenex

Sanitizing wipes - we use these A LOT

Pre-packaged healthy snacks - granola bars, crackers, etc.

These will be used if a student does not have their own snack.

1st Grade Supply List 2023-2024

The following list has recommended supplies for your child. Favorite brands are suggested based on overall quality, durability and longevity with heavy first grade use. Please label all supplies with your child's name prior to sending them to school. Thank you!

PENCILS: Ticonderoga pre-sharpened

STOKES: Shared supply with class and no name labels

ZOERHOF: Individual supply and label with name

ERASERS: (Consider a mix of standard size and pencil top. Please NO jumbo erasers.)

CRAYONS: 2-3 boxes Crayola brand 24 crayons

COLORED PENCILS: Crayola Twistable Colored Pencils (Reduces sharpening!)

GLUE STICKS: quantity 10

SCISSORS: Fiskars brand

PENCIL SHARPENER: Must have a container to hold shavings and no electric/battery operated sharpeners

HIGHLIGHTERS: quantity 2

SOFT SIDED ZIPPER LUNCH BAG: This will be used to hold SCHOOL SUPPLIES for easy transport between learning spaces.

HEADPHONES: Over the ear/head, quality/built for daily use (NO EARBUDS)

POST-IT BRAND NOTES: quantity 6-8 pads

DRY ERASE MARKERS: quantity 8-10

WATER BOTTLE

INDOOR SHOES: Students must have shoes appropriate for P.E. If you are able to keep that pair in your child's locker it can be helpful! This is also helpful during the winter months to switch with winter boots.

BACKPACK: Please consider a larger, roomy size backpack to hold all the daily gear.

2ND GRADE SUPPLY LIST

10 sharpened pencils

Pencil box

Box of crayons

Headphones

Glue sticks

Colored pencils (twistables are a great option)

Water bottle

Pair of scissors

Small container, such as a butter tub, with 4 quarters, 10 dimes, 10 nickels, and 10 pennies clearly labeled with child's name

3rd GRADE SUPPLY LIST

All students will need:

Backpack without wheels (smaller is better for fitting in tight spots)

Pencil Pouch

Comfortable headphones in a labeled Ziploc baggy. You WILL want a backup pair on hand at home. These often do not last through the year.

Indoor PE shoes

Crayons - no larger than 24 count

Colored pencils

Glue Sticks

3 to 5 pads of sticky notes (3" x 3")

Individual water bottle (labeled w/student name)

Pencils (Ticonderoga work very well)

Individual pouches of tissues

A handheld pencil sharpener that catches shavings
(OPTIONAL)
