### Why are you running for Hamilton Community School's board of education?

### What particular experiences or skills have prepared you to serve as a board member?

In this role, I initiated a special needs ministry, became trauma-informed to better support my students, researched and implemented curriculum to achieve yearly goals, and developed a volunteer team to lead and teach the children in their care.

Currently, I work with Family Bound, an organization that collaborates with local DHHS and faith-based agencies to recruit, retain, and support foster families in our counties.

As a mother of nine children and having cared for over 15 additional children in the past 18 years, I bring extensive experience working with children of diverse ages and backgrounds. My personal experience with children who excel in school and those who face significant challenges has given me a broad perspective on the varying needs of students in our community. I believe it is crucial to help students identify their unique learning styles to ensure their success.
