Our district is using Securly to keep students safe on their school-issued devices. As part of our commitment to your child's safety, we're giving all of our school's parents access to the free Securly Home app.

The Securly Home app will be available for Hamilton families beginning Monday, Nov. 15. You will receive a Securly Parent App email that day for account setup details.

To get started:


1: Download the Securly Home App

View your child's real-time activity feed, right from the palm of your hand.


With the **Securly Home app**, you'll have a real-time view of your child's activity on their school device. You'll also get weekly emails from Securly with a snapshot report of that week's activity.













2: Open the app and tap the Login button

Enter the email address you have registered with your child's school and tap the "Get instant access" button.

Check your email from your phone, click on the link, and that's it! Your account is ready to go.

3: Your home, your rules.

Create your own rules for when your child's school device comes home.


See the quick highlights of what your child has been up to online, updated every 24 hours.

The Securly Home app will notify you of any flagged activities pointing to self-harm or bullying related to your child.


Offline schedules

Set offline schedules for your child's internet like dinner and bedtime and Securly Home does the rest.

Pause internet

Pause internet access on your child's school device when it is at home with the touch of a button.

Hamilton Community Schools will not permit student access to pornography, drugs, or gambling on any school-issued devices. However, parents can control categories like social media, games, and messaging.
